Major Banks Agree to Sign ISDA Resolution Stay Protocol ([Press Release](#) and [Backgrounder](#))

ISDA announced that 18 major global banks (G-18) have agreed to sign a new ISDA Resolution Stay Protocol, which has been developed in coordination with the Financial Stability Board to support cross-border resolution and reduce systemic risk. This represents a major step in strengthening systemic stability and reducing the risk that banks are considered 'too big to fail'.
