COMMITTEE ACTIVITIES

Stephen O'Connor, Chairman, Robert Pickel, CEO and Japanese Board members of ISDA met with Governor Shirakawa at Bank of Japan and other senior official to exchange views on the recent issues on OTC derivatives market and regulatory issues including the extraterritoriality of US and European regulations mainly in relation to clearing mandate.

Stephen O'Connor, Chairman, and Japanese Board members of ISDA visited senior officials at the Financial Services Agency (FSA), including Mr. Masamichi Kono, Vice Commissioner for International Affairs and Mr. Jun Mizuguchi, Assistant Commissioner for International Affairs. Topic of discussions included the extraterritoriality of the U.S. regulations on OTC derivatives, margin requirements for non-centrally cleared derivatives as well as Libor.

ISDA met with the FSA and Bank of Japan to exchange views on the proposed rules for margin requirements for non-centrally cleared derivatives by BCBS/IOSCO. Japanese members shared serious concerns of the impact on Japanese market and the participants if the rules are to be implemented as proposed.

On November 14, Japan Operations Committee meeting was held. The guest speaker was Oliver Stuart, Managing Director, Global Head of Derivative Operations at Morgan Stanley, who provided the members with an update on the global operational issues and ongoing global authorities initiatives on a regulation reform of OTC Derivatives covering DFA, EMIR framework areas affecting controls in Japan and Asia. Mr. Stuart is the co-Chair of the ISDA Operations Steering Committee (OSC), and an active member of the ISDA Industry Governance Committee (IIGC).
