OTC Derivatives Working Group

ISDA Japan OTC Derivatives Working Group submitted the interim report to Japan FSA on November 12, with a follow up meeting. The interim report summarized the issues on the expansion of the scope of clearing obligations scheduled around November 2014. Key issues discussed in the report are as follows:

- Careful consideration is necessary on the scope of entities (clients) subject to the mandatory clearing including a phase-in approach, taking into account the feasibility of the clearing brokers and a clearing house.
- 2) It is necessary to set a scope of products, taking into account the equivalence with the US and European regulations on mandatory clearing.
- 3) Implementation timeline and phase-in schedule should be harmonized with margin requirements for uncleared derivatives as much as possible.

The Financial Instruments and Exchange Act

Japan FSA published the consultative draft (Japanese only) of the official notice which designates the scope of products to be exempted from registration requirements for clearing houses providing "Financial Instruments Obligation Assumption Service" or clearing service. The draft notice also designates which clearing houses are exempted for this purpose, and propose to extend the deadline of the outstanding exemption from December 31, 2013 to December 31, 2014. Members were requested to provide comments before the submission deadline, December 18.
